The life of a **FREE RANGE PIG**

All sows are free range.

Are born in pig shelters in open fields.

No tail docking, nor teeth cut.

Weaned from the sow after five weeks.

Once weaned, the piglets are transferred to housing where they always have access to outdoor areas in the form of open-air runs/areas.

Has access to straw in resting areas and the opportunity to move about.

Conventional vegetarian feed and lots of roughage, so the pigs naturally feel replete.

Stricter rules for the use of medication – twice as long a withdrawal period.

Recommended by Animal Protection Denmark.

Awarded three out of three hearts at the governmental animal welfare label: 'Bedre Dyrevelfærd'.

Always Danish pork – from pigs born, reared and slaughtered in Denmark.
