

The life of a **Free Range pig**

- All sows are free range.
- Are born in pig shelters in open fields.
- Weaned from the sow after five weeks.
- Once weaned, the piglets are transferred to housing where they always have access to outdoor areas in the form of open-air runs/areas.
- No tail docking, nor teeth cut.
- Has access to straw in resting areas and the opportunity to move about.
- Conventional vegetarian feed and lots of roughage, so the pigs naturally feel replete.
- Stricter rules for the use of medication – twice as long a withdrawal period.
- Recommended by the Danish Animal Welfare Society.
- Awarded three out of three hearts at the governmental animal welfare label: 'Bedre Dyrevelfærd'.
- Always Danish pork – from pigs born, reared and slaughtered in Denmark.



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
